Region is not required to file taxes with IRS, so it is reasonable to assume that Area isn't required either. The deadline for the CAR (Conference Agenda Report) motions is August 29th and it will be available on November 26th, 2007. The approval form for the Sixth Edition of the Basic Text will be out on September 1, 2007. The best time for the workshop that's been talked about is in July. Region will be setting up a hotel liaison if a rotation schedule for the conventions can be agreed upon.
