I recently attended the virtual Southern Zonal Forum PR and fellowship development workshop, which is held on the second Tuesday of each month. It was a great experience, and I plan to continue attending monthly. I am particularly interested in the regional project focused on gathering email addresses for professional institutions and clinics to improve outreach. We are also considering scheduling a virtual workshop to inform these professionals about Narcotics Anonymous. Locally, PR is planning a Fellowship development workshop soon; more details will be revealed soon.

The World Convention of Narcotics Anonymous (WCNA) 39 will be held in Dublin, Ireland, in July 2028. I look forward to seeing some of you there.

I also attended the new "Hope in Recovery" meeting to help guide them in carrying a clear message. They meet at 3907 Leigh on Thursday at 7:00 PM, and on Friday and Saturday at noon.

Regarding our outreach efforts, the QR code was accessed 70 times this past month. Specifically, stickers were hit 14 times, the meeting schedule with pull tabs 25 times, and RBS registration 31 times. To support these efforts, I have ordered 1,000 QR code stickers featuring the meeting schedule to disperse throughout our area, along with additional IPs.
