☑ We spoke with the body regarding the misappropriation of RBS funds to ensure we are

- o The body assured us that we have done everything appropriately.
- o We spoke with Tom K. emailed the 2018 TBRNA audit which includes letters, police reports and other useful documents we may find helpful in our pursuit.
- ☑ We spoke with our RD, Reuben P., who has agreed to come to our area and do a presentation for our GSR's and any other member who would like to learn the voting process for our RD' and RDA's. This will also include a CARS workshop.
- o The tentative proposed dates for this workshop are Sunday, March 1 st , and Saturday, March 21 st .

☑ There were regional positions that were filled; however, the regional Policy position remains open for anyone interested. You must have 3 years continuous clean time. Please see the regional policy at TBRNA.org for other qualifications for this position.

☑ Sponsorship Behind The Walls is a subcommittee in region who is putting together a program and looking for volunteers for members willing to sponsor inmates who are getting out on parole. We currently have 62 volunteers but would like to get to 100 before the program launches to make sure the members of NA can accommodate sponsorship of the inmates.
