- *Treasurer* Starting balance was \$1,555.73. The current balance is \$930.54. The prudent reserve is \$2,587.48. Total money coming in was \$258.25. Total money out was \$1,405.44.
- *RCM 1* CBANA is hosting the next RSC meeting on Saturday, May 10th, 2025 at RCI on 626 Robinson.
- *H&I* Last meeting was held April 25th, 2025 at 6:30pm at the Coastal Bend Recovery Club at 3307 Ayers. Detox panel is held on Saturday's at Cenikor at 6:30pm and Residential at 7:00pm.
