Good morning family .. so I made a deposit for \$850 yesterday and didn't realize till it was too late that the deposit was made to the RBS account and the bank statement they gave me was also for the RBS account so I don't have an official up to date financial report.. so I'm going to give a breakdown of what I know was deposited this month till I get the statement next week for an official report...

We collected \$1055 at the event support on 5/8

Out of that we spent \$75 on rent to the CBRC, \$61.70 on pizza and \$35.84 on drinks bringing us to a profit of \$882.46..

We had a donation from activities for \$101, SIS \$20, Recovery101 \$20, and Off The Wall \$48

That brings us to a deposit of \$1071.46.. well we don't have a way to take credit cards for area so RBS too them for us to allow us to sell the shirts at the event and take card for the auction so they owe us a check for \$223.. well now they will need to make the check out for \$1073 because I deposited the money into their account by mistake.. this will all be fixed ASAP I will work on fixing it Monday morning.. we also have \$340 cash from t-shirt sales that needs to be deposited and we have 31 shirts we need to sale also that will all go into our area account..
