I'm still awaiting to receive the records from Judy. (Judy texted me Friday evening, July 18th, that she had four boxes to give me that evening but failed to contact me at the meeting. She planned to finish gathering the materials yesterday.) I have calculated the balances for both the CBANA and CBANA Literature account based on the March to June bank statements I have and worked backward to arrive at what should be an accurate balance barring any outstanding checks issued prior to March 1st. According to how the check book has been marked there may be some that would cause this balance to be adjusted.

There is a \$70.00 discrepancy on the CBANA Literature account for the May Deposit. My records and teller receipt reflect a \$210.00 deposit. The statement contained a substitute document for \$140.00. The above deposit amount reflects what the bank shows. Once I have submitted the signature cards and minutes to the bank then I will be able to go in and discuss the matter with them. Until then they cannot discuss this with me as I am not recognized by the bank as a signer on the account.

I have categorized the Subcommittee Status amounts based on the descriptions. I suspect there are some amounts categorized improperly but I still don't have a copy of the budget to work from. I will revise the breakdown once I receive the budget.

I hope to have received the records and all accounts brought up to date by the next meeting. I am still in need of a copy of the budget.
