  - Orders were \$788.55 plus \$362.40 totaling \$1150.95 adding fees of \$9.50 equals a balance of \$123.98

➤ ***Phone Line –***

- We have 15 volunteers. We've had 6 calls in the last 30 days. The average call was 3 minutes.
- All shifts are covered however we need a male to cover Saturday and Sundays from 5:00 PM to 11:59 PM

➤ ***PR/PI –***

- Group content is the means by which we bring the spiritual awakening of the 12 steps to bear in making service-related decisions. It is fundamental to our fellowship's decision-making process. It is not, however, merely A euphemism for voting and is not itself the innate decision-making process.
- PR has continued to hang Flyers at local restaurants, coffee shops, and small businesses. The QR code is still hanging on our city bus system inside the bus. And our ongoing spirit of service workshop/meeting has been small but consistent.
