- To pay all admin fees in October (Heading V. Financial Provisions, section B Area Budgets, item 2)
- Add exception to "recurring expenses shall be paid by check" to say "auto-drafts are allowed for instances where auto-drafts are required to M the service" (i.e., phone line) (Heading V. Financial Provisions, section C Expenses & Reimbursements, item 1)
