# **COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

#### Treasurer Report – Absent. No report.

The bank will go ahead and clear the check with a \$25 charge. Should we ask Lester to pay for the charges? We will bring it up in Old Business, when Lester is here. **RCM 1/RCM 2 Report -** Bea read the report. Learning Day will be October 29<sup>th</sup> from 2 to 5pm at the Anchor Club. The topic will be "Building Stronger Home Groups". Zane will be there. Region is Nov. 10<sup>th</sup> in Austin- she needs to know who's going. Bill says that the TBRCNA 8 pre-registration deadline is November 21<sup>st</sup>. #### Hospitals and Institutions - Absent. No report.

Activities – The attendance was great at the Play Day. Thanks to everyone for helping. The breakdown of the money is as follows: \$150 – Joe B., \$75 – jumper, \$50 – rent, \$86.26 – meat, \$43.26 – paper goods & coffee, \$24.38 – trash bags & charcoal (\$428.90 total spent). That left a balance of \$71.10 (from the \$500 requested) and in the donation can was \$180.33. Mandy is turning in a total of \$251.43. Ed says that there were 80 people at the event. Paul said the fellowship is good here in our Area. The next event will be the Halloween Dance at Charlie's on Sat. Oct. 27<sup>th</sup> at 9pm. \$3 per person and \$5 per couple, and \$1 off if you wear a costume. Joe B. cannot be the DJ for the rest of the year. She has found another DJ, who price is \$175 (still a great deal). Bea says that he is worth the extra \$25. The next sub-committee meeting will be Nov. 2<sup>nd</sup> at 7pm at OTW. Mandy is requesting \$300.00 to fund the event.

**Literature** – Dedee will give the money she has directly to Lester. She has copies of the Approval Draft of the 6<sup>th</sup> Edition of the Basic Text for \$8.50. Dawn asked about the items that were donated last month. No word yet on if they got it. Dedee says thank you to Carrie for helping at this Area.

#### Web Servant – Absent. No report.

**RBS** – had a lot of support at the last sub-committee meeting at OTW. Bill suggested the deadline for the artwork should be by Feb. at region. There will be two people selling shirts this year. The dates for RBS will be July 25,25, and  $27^{th}$ , 2008. The theme will be "never alone never again, together we can". Artwork is due by Nov  $15^{th}$ . The next subcommittee meeting will be Nov.  $16^{th}$  at 7pm at OTW.

Outreach – Absent. No report.

**Recorder** – Cindy needs to be reimbursed for ink - \$21.64, will give receipt to Lester at next Area.

**Southern Zonal Forum** – They are till working on artwork ideas. The hotel is finally worked out. People can make reservations as of now. Casino Night is still on. The coffee pots are taken care of. Peggy will be helping with coordinating transportation from the airport. Judy asked if the new people know about the CAR (Conference Agenda Report). Bea explained the CAR – for example in the  $6^{th}$  Edition of the Basic Text, the stories were changed because of the CAR. It's *us* being able to have a vote, worldwide. What we do here at Southern Zonal Forum goes straight to World.

# **OLD BUSINESS:**

1) POLICY CHANGE – To increase RBS seed money to \$4000.

CON- Wayne stated the 11<sup>th</sup> concept about holding on to funds. We are supposed to use the funds to further NA as a whole. Funds should not bottleneck. RBS used to ask Area each month for the money to support the event. It shouldn't be a burden to Area. CON – Dawn suggests increasing the cost of merchandise of registration to offset some of the event costs. This should be a burden to others. Dedee suggests increasing the amount of items in the raffle. Area can only do 2 raffles per year and the tickets have to be specially printed.

CON – Judy statement is linked to Wayne said. We have other things that are needed for Area, like literature.

PRO – Micky

PRO – David T. says that RBS had to struggle to get the tent this year (money wise). Next year the prices for the tent will be \$1300 compared to this year's \$700. Increasing the seed money will give RBS more options and also make it bigger.

Wayne said that the seed money was increased last time for the same reasons. Historically, there has been *no* money right before RBS.

Dedee asked if it was profitable to have the Iceman out there? We need to put it on the flyer that ice will be sold.

PRO – Dan S. says raise the seed money and sees no point in raising the cost of registration. The event still needs to be affordable. CONSENSUS -YES

2) <u>POLICY CHANGE</u> – To vote in the new co-chair for RBS in September (take nominations in August) and to propose seed money adjustments in August, too. CONSENSUS –YES

3) <u>POLICY CHANGE</u> – *Clean time requirement for RBS co-chair will be 3 years at the time of vote in September, cannot be waived.* CONSENSUS – YES 4) <u>POLICY CHANGE</u> – To change the version of the service prayer used in this Area's policy to the correct one found the Basic Text. We need to add, "that this may be truly your work, not ours" after "grant us a bond of selflessness". CONSENSUS – YES

5) <u>PROPOSAL WITHDRAWN</u> - When we have an amount over \$200 that is being requested, it needs to be taken back to the groups for approval. They wanted to amend the proposal to \$300 for activities. Someone wanted clarification from the Treasurer's report on what money has been given to Activities and what has been turned back in. The Treasurer's report doesn't make that clear. Wayne proposed an Adhoc committee. Dawn says that it is a revolving account, not a budget. Judy says that they've always brought money back in. PROPOSAL WITHDRAWN

**NEW BUSINESS:** Nominations

<u>Treasurer</u> – Gem City nominates Judy. Judy accepts the nomination and qualifies herself.

<u>RCM 1</u> – no nominations. 2 year term, 3 year clean time requirement.

<u>CoFacilitator</u> – Gem City nominates Wayne. Wayne accepts the nomination and qualifies himself.

<u>Recorder</u> – Bea nominated Cindy. Cindy declined. No other nominations. One year term, one year clean time requirement.

<u>RBS CoChair</u> – Gem City nominates Bea. Bea accepts the nomination and qualifies herself.

Mandy was already nominated, accepts the nomination and qualifies herself. Norman was nominated, but was not present to accept or qualify himself.

Activities – no nominations. Two year term, two year clean time requirement.

Dawn wants to be Regional Delegate Alternate (RDA). Nominations are being accepted next month at Region in Austin. Voting for the position will be in the spring.

## **FINANCIAL BUSINESS:**

Activities – is requesting \$300 for the October event Recorder – needs to be reimbursed \$21.64 for ink RCM1/RCM2 – is requesting \$200 for travel and lodging for Region

## **OPEN FORUM:**

Bea proposes to create a Policy Chair/Advisor who would be responsible for knowing Area policy, and keeping policy up to date. This person should be able to advise this body when policy questions come up. CONSENSUS – YES
